

## **Used Equipment**

Used equipment, like sporting and recreational equipment, must be declared on your passenger arrival card. This type of equipment can transfer soil and plant material from other countries into Fiji that may carry pests, diseases, and seeds – all of which can pose a threat to our environment and wildlife.

Equipment might be inspected on arrival so it should be easy to reach in your luggage. If you are unsure about whether or not your equipment needs inspecting – declare it. Used equipment includes:

- All hiking and sporting footwear, including gaiters for tramping – or any footwear used outside of urban areas – which should be cleaned prior to arrival and be free of soil
- Tents and any camping equipment
- All camping foods
- Hunting gear, including clothing and backpacks
- Any equipment used with animals such as:
  - farm footwear
  - Vet supplies.
  - Horse riding equipment, saddles, and bridle gear
  - Animal shearing equipment, including clothing used while shearing animals
  - Gardening equipment
- All equipment – like clothing, footwear and tools – used for work in industries such as horticulture, viticulture (wine production), apiculture (beekeeping), aquaculture (fish farming), and forestry.
