

## Biosecurity Alert for inclusion of FNPF compliance certificate with Exporter Renewal for 2020

The Biosecurity Authority would like to officially notify all Exporters that from 2020 all export license renewals and Biosecurity Approve Premises (“BAP”) renewals will need to be accompanied by a Fiji National Provident Fund (“FNPF”) compliance certificate together with a Fiji Revenue and Customs Services (“FRCS”) compliance certificate.

This is to ensure that all exporters registered are compliant with FNPF & FRCS requirements.

All export BAP premises will be valid from January to December.

Please note that failure to obtain either FNPF or FRCS registration certificate or compliance certificate will result in non-issuance of Export License and BAP compliance certificates.
