

Implementation of National Budget 2021-2022 - Fijian Government Financial Relief Support - COVID-19: BAF Fees for Agricultural Exports only

As announced in the National Budget 2021-2022 on 16 July 2021, the Fijian Government will provide financial Relief for Biosecurity Authority of Fiji fees and charges for Agricultural Exports only. In-line with this, effective from 1 August 2021 to 31 July 2022, all Biosecurity Authority of Fiji's fees and charges related to Agricultural Exports for personal and commercial consignments will not be paid by exporters.

Kindly note there are no changes to BAF's requirements for exports. BAF and importing countries requirements must be fully met and diligently adhered to, to sustain the existing bilateral export agreements and other trade pathways that Fiji enjoys with different countries.

BAF envisions that the relief in fees and charges will provide incentives to all existing and emerging exporters to take advantage of this initiative. This relief will contribute immensely to increasing Fijian grown and produced products market shares to many more countries globally whilst observing all biosecurity compliance protocols in a bio-secure manner.
